

Daily Prayer Inspiration and Ideas

If you are in need of a little inspiration in your daily prayer, here are a few ideas to get you started.

Monday 3/14/16

God wants a relationship with us – not one where we just do all the talking, but where he speaks as well. Take time to simply be quiet and ask God to speak to you. Most of us don't hear an audible response, but keep your eyes and ears open throughout the day to how he might be speaking – maybe through a bible passage that jumps off the page, through a Christian Brother or Sister...

Tuesday, 3/15/16

Have you ever felt prompted by God or nudged by the Holy Spirit? This week, commit to following those promptings and see where it leads you.

Wednesday, 3/16/16

Prayer rituals can help us stay connected to God throughout the day. For example, some people stop and pray anytime they hear an ambulance; others pray for those in hunger before they eat lunch; others might use an afternoon break time to thank God for times of rest. Today think about a ritual you might incorporate into your day. Try it out this week, asking God to help you keep near to him.

Thursday 3/17/16

Some people are known as “people of prayer” – true prayer warriors who seem to have this whole prayer thing down. If you were facing emergency surgery, who would you call to pray for you. Thank God for that person in your life and maybe write them a note, letting them know you appreciate their prayer strength.

Friday 3/18/16

How can you become a prayer warrior? What practices do you need to incorporate in your life to be someone who powerfully prays for others? Ask God to reveal this to you and make those changes. Begin by simply praying for those in your life.

Saturday, 3/19/16

In Luke 12:48 God says, “From everyone who has been given much, much will be demanded; and from the one who has been entrusted with much, much more will be asked.” How would you describe the “much” that you have been given by God? Thank God for all that he has given you.

Sunday 3/20/16

Thinking back to the verse from yesterday, what “much” might God be asking you to give up for the purpose of meeting other people's needs. Ask God to show this to you and give you the strength to follow his prompting.
